The session will take place July 21 - 25 from 8:30 am - 4:00 pm each day. Transportation to and from a central pick-up point in Providence is available.

The curriculum will include:

- Highway Design

- Water Resources
- Environmental Engineering
- Geographic Information Systems
- Geotechnical Engineering

The Academy will be led by a URI engineering professor and other URI engineering faculty, URI undergraduate and graduate engineering students and industry professionals.

Students must:

- be in the 9th*, 10th, 11th or 12th grade for the 2014-2015 school year.

 *9th graders may only apply if they've previously participated in the URITC's STI program.
- have at least a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale).
- have an interest in a math, science, engineering or a transportation related career.
- write an essay and provide a copy of your most recent report card.

A brief interview with each applicant will be scheduled by the program director.

All costs, including meals, field trips and supplies, will be covered by the Rhode Island Department of Transportation's educational outreach programs and the Federal Highway Administration.
