Colorado ASSET, effective April 29th, 2013, allows all qualified Colorado high school graduates to pay the in-state tuition rate at Colorado public institutions of higher education regardless of immigration status with some conditions:

Students who graduated on or after Sept. 1, 2013 must have:

- 1. Attended a Colorado high school for three years immediately before earning a high school diploma or GED in Colorado.**
- 2. Been admitted (not enrolled) to a public institution of higher education in Colorado within 12 months of graduation or GED.**
- 3. Complete the COF application and affidavit stating the student has or will apply for legal U.S. presence when they are able to do so.**

Students who graduated before Sept. 1, 2013 must have:

- 1. Attended a Colorado high school for three years immediately before earning a diploma or GED in Colorado.**
- 2. Been admitted to a public institution of higher education in Colorado.**
- 3. Prove they have been physically present in Colorado for the past 18 months prior to enrollment.**
- 4. Complete the COF application and affidavit stating the student has or will apply for legal U.S. presence when they are able to do so.**
