## Colorado ASSET



Learn how students without proof of legal U.S. residency may still qualify for in-state tuition rates.

Colorado ASSET, effective April 29th, 2013, allows all qualified Colorado high school graduates to pay the in-state tuition rate at Colorado public institutions of higher education regardless of immigration status with some conditions:

Students who graduated on or after Sept. 1, 2013 must have:

- Attended a Colorado high school for three years immediately before earning a high school diploma or GED in Colorado.
- 2. Been admitted (not enrolled) to a public institution of higher education in Colorado within 12 months of graduation or GED.
- Complete the COF application and affidavit stating the student has or will apply for legal U.S. presence when they are able to do so.

Students who graduated before Sept. 1, 2013 must have:

- Attended a Colorado high school for three years immediately before earning a diploma or GED in Colorado.
- 2. Been admitted to a public institution of higher education in Colorado.
- 3. Prove they have been physically present in Colorado for the past 18 months prior to enrollment.
- Complete the COF application and affidavit stating the student has or will apply for legal U.S. presence when they are able to do so.
