Password Rules Change

XAP takes privacy and the safety of personal data very seriously. That's why we are making changes to the password rules for student, parent and adult account holders this summer. These changes help us help you follow data security best practices and will improve security for your users' data.

Here's an overview of what will be changing this summer:

- All new and reset passwords must abide by the following rules:
 - o The password must be between 8 and 12 characters long (currently, student, parent and adult account holders can have passwords between 5 and 12 characters long).
 - The password must contain both alphabetic and numeric characters, but cannot have special characters or spaces.
 - o The password cannot match their account name.
- Every student, parent and adult account holder will be **required to reset their password** upon their first sign-in after the password changes go into effect this summer.
- Users will be asked to choose a security question and answer when they are resetting their passwords.
- Users will also be given the option of providing an alternative email address and cell phone number to help with password retrieval.
