



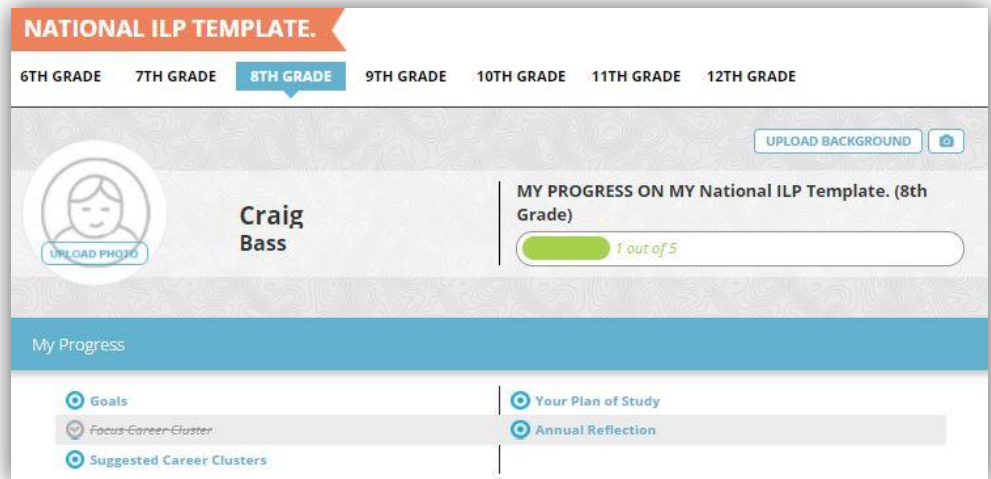

Read on to learn some of the great resources on Choices360 that you can use to help your students meet state, district or local benchmarks to become career and college ready.

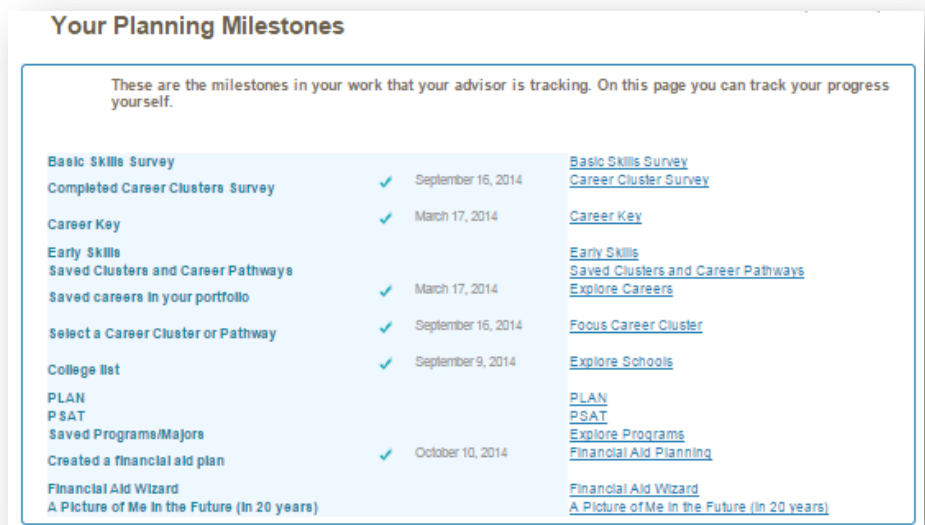
CAREER AND COLLEGE READINESS BENCHMARKS MEASUREMENT TOOLS ON CHOICES360

In addition to a large number of individual features, Choices360 also gives the professional tools that can be used to measure student benchmarks encompassing multiple features. Using these tools, an educator can monitor their students' progress towards completion of state, district, or local benchmarks intended to insure students are career and college ready. The following tools are available to professionals on Choices360 for measuring student attainment of benchmarks.

1. **The ILP (Individual Learning Plan).** The ILP is designed to meet the needs of professionals who have state, district or school ILP mandates, as well as professionals who would like to use the tool to organize benchmarks for students to complete in a simple, tabbed feature. The name, "ILP", can be customized.



2. **Milestones.** Milestones are another tool that allows the professional and the student to monitor progress towards meeting designated benchmarks. Once assigned, Milestones record completed activities and date stamp them accordingly. Students can click the link to the right of any Milestone, completed or not completed, to review the activity, or to complete one not yet attempted.





ILP AND MILESTONES: COMPARISONS AND CONTRASTS

Use the following chart to help you decide which tool, or tools, to use with your students.

	ILPs	Milestones
Who sets them up?	One or more default ILP sets are available on Choices360. The site administrator at each site can duplicate, then customize one of the sets, or create new ILP sets at any time.	A default set of Milestones is available on Choices360. The site administrator at each site can change these at any time.
What is different in how a student or client uses each?	ILP activities can be completed in any order. The ILP page displays results for completed activities or invites the student to begin activities they have not yet completed.	Milestones activities can be completed in any order. As a student or client completes a milestone activity anywhere on the site, the milestones page shows a check mark for activities completed with completion date noted.
Where on the site is each located?	If an ILP has been assigned to a grade, role or group, those students may access their ILP from the Home screen and also in Your Portfolio.	If Milestones have been assigned to a grade or role, those students can view the Milestones assigned to them in the “Your Planning Milestones” section of Your Portfolio.
Can guidance be provided to the student or client to direct them through the activities?	Site administrators may add introductory text and/or upload introductory documents to the ILP as well as to its sections and activities.	Little to no guidance is available with Milestones.
How can I track student progress through the activities?	The ILP Tracking Report is available on the Reports tab in the Professional Center of Choices360.	The Milestones Tracking Report is available on the Reports tab in the Professional Center of Choices360.
