## ***RELEASE NOTES SUMMARY***

This release includes the following:

- **Additional Connect to Student Account Panel for Parents** – Parents can now more easily connect to their students accounts through the parent landing page.
- **New Pre-ACT Activity** – A new test score activity has been added to Your Portfolio in the student center for the PreACT test.
- **Enhanced WorkKeys Test Score Activity** – The WorkKeys test scores activity now follows the same format as SAT, ACT etc., with a new modern design and layout and has been updated to reflect the assessment name changes.

# 1. ADDITIONAL CONNECT TO STUDENT ACCOUNT PANEL FOR PARENTS

To make it easier for parent or guardians to connect to their student's account, the parent landing page now includes guidance on how to have a student connect their account – and if the student has already issued an invitation to the parent, then the link for the parent to connect is available.

## 2. NEW PREACT TEST SCORE ACTIVITY

There is a new test score activity for the PreACT in the College Planning section of Your Portfolio. The activity has a modern design and function (following the pattern of recently updated or added test score activities). It includes fields for the date the test was taken, and a slider for the test scores.

Professionals can use the new PreACT test score activity as a milestone or include it in an Individual Learning Plan (ILP) – also known as an Individual Career and Academic Plan (ICAP), Personal Education Plan (PEP) or Student Success Plan (SSP).

### 3. ENHANCED WORKKEYS TEST SCORE ACTIVITY

The WorkKeys test scores activity has been updated with a new modern design and layout and now follows the same format other test scores in the Portfolio. It has also been updated to reflect the assessment name changes and scale score ranges.

The test score names have been updated as follows:

- “App. Math” is now Applied Math
- “Locating info” is now Graphic Literacy
- “Read. For Info.” is now Workplace Documents

The scale score ranges for tests taken after June 2017 are now 65-90.
