RELEASE NOTES SUMMARY

These release notes detail the product improvements and new features included in the April 29th release.

Resolved Issues (formerly improvement report)

- When a professional account holder updates their email address, the updated email address was not updating properly in the Professional Center Communication tool.
- The keyword search on the Explore Careers page was returning incorrect results.

Enhanced & New Features

- In the Professional Center, the link to the Companion account is now a button so it's more visible.

(79486) | The code was reviewed and updated so the updated email address appears immediately in the Communication tool. |
| 2 | Student Center: When a student used the Search Careers functionality on the Explore Careers page to search for a specific career, the results were inconsistent and occasionally unclear. Additionally, results were shown in alphabetical order rather than best match. (77984). | The search query was revised to prioritize, and display results based upon the following: title, alternative titles, and career description |
