3	In some circumstances, students could not change the status of their saved college in My Colleges & Applications. (PPS-722)	The code was repaired.
4	The instructional text for the assigned activity "My Reviews and Comments" was missing. (PPS-668)	The text has been added.
5	Text was not wrapping properly for the Volunteering & Community Service activity. (PPS-448)	The styling issue was fixed.
6	In the Sign In content block, links to Create an Account and Forgot Your Username were not displaying appropriately causing accessibility issues. (PPS-923)	The issue has been resolved.
