RELEASE NOTES SUMMARY

These release notes detail the product improvements and new features included in the November 21, 2022, release.

Resolved Issues

1. The Assignment & Curriculum report has been corrected to display the last edited date rather than the first achieved date.
2. When using the Batch Creation template, any records containing an incorrectly formatted date of birth will now be rejected.
3. The account wizard will now save the student's date of birth when the account was created via Single Sign On (SSO).

Enhanced & New Features

- The date of birth validation on student account creation has been updated.
- The Last Sign-in Date has been added to Find Student – Browse By Class.
- New postsecondary profile data.
- An enhancement was made to the Group Builder.


1. RESOLVED ISSUES

This table summarizes the product improvements included in the November 21, 2022, release.

	Problem	Improvement
1	The Assignment & Curriculum report was not always displaying the correct date. (PPS-2573)	The Assignment & Curriculum report has been corrected to display the last edited date rather than the first achieved date.
2	When using the Batch Creation template, if a date of birth is entered in the incorrect format, the record was not rejected causing the username to be generated incorrectly. (PPS-2702)	When using the Batch Creation template, any records containing a date of birth entered with the incorrect format will now be rejected.
3	There is an issue with student accounts created via Single Sign On (SSO). When the account wizard loads upon the students first login, the wizard not saving the date of birth. (PPS-2851)	Students with accounts created via Single Sign On (SSO) will now be able to update their date of birth in the account wizard.

2. STUDENT ACCOUNT CREATION: DATE OF BIRTH

Validation has been added to the date of birth field on the student account creation page. If a date of birth is entered that is under 7 years of age, the following message will be displayed. 'You must be 7 years old to create an account.'

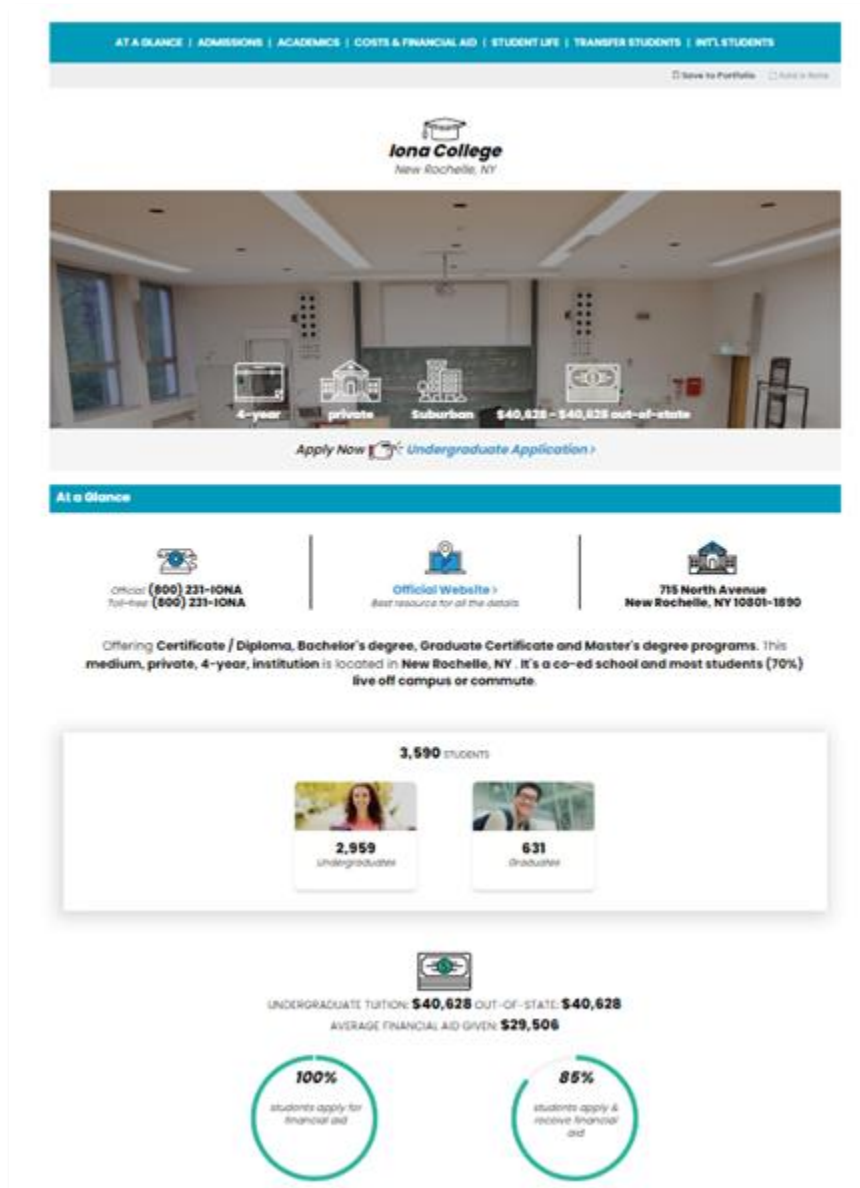

5. GROUP BUILDER ENHANCEMENT

An enhancement has been made to the Group Builder. When viewing a group, the Edit and Delete buttons have been removed and a menu has been added to the left side of the screen. This menu will provide group editing functionality.
