Resolved Issues

1. When viewing a Work-Based Learning Opportunity in which the application due date is in the past, the label has been updated to read, "Due date has passed".
2. When printing out a Career Cluster, the 'Pathways in this Cluster' section will now be included in the .pdf.
3. Resolved an issue with merging accounts where the message alerting the professional user that the student has recently logged in was missing.

- Your Journal has been updated to use improved form and button styling when adding or editing a journal entry.

The following updates to the Work-Based Learning module have been made to provide more clarification when working with organizations and opportunities.

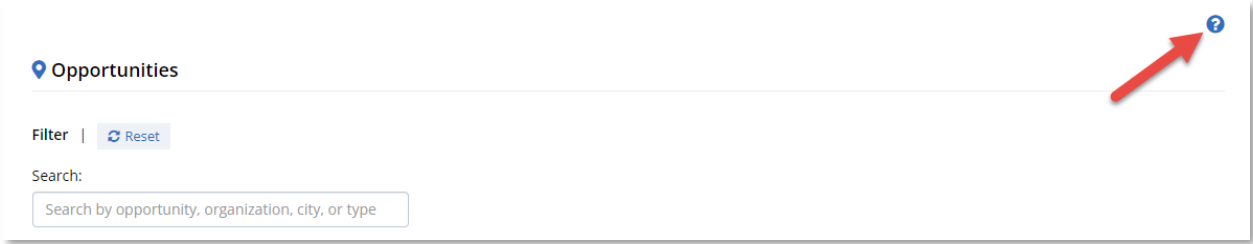
The organization address fields have been updated to indicate that the address is the address of the organization's headquarters and not necessarily where the opportunity is located.

3. EFC CALCULATOR UPDATES

The Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) Calculator styles have been updated in both the Financial Planning and the portfolio activity to use improved form and button styling. Additionally, both the Save and Cancel buttons are displayed after the EFC estimates are saved.

Estimated Family Contribution (EFC)

One of the most important numbers in the financial aid process for you and your family is the Expected Family Contribution or EFC. The EFC is the amount your family is expected to contribute towards paying for college. The federal government will determine your EFC when you file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, or FAFSA.

Keep in mind that the estimate of financial need shown can vary significantly among the colleges to which you are applying for aid.

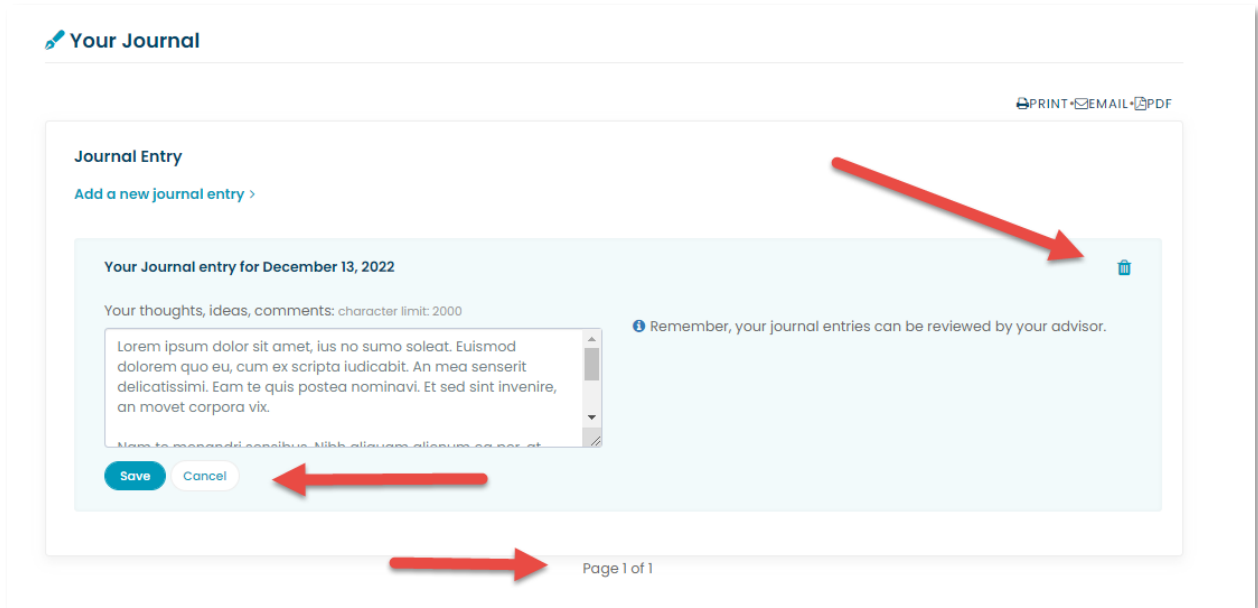
This is because each college sets its own policy about how to determine eligibility for their private funds. Therefore, your final offer of financial aid may be higher or lower than is indicated by this calculator.
