
The Department of Education is updating the FAFSA form. All articles referencing the FAFSA open date were updated to indicate the new form will not be open until December 2023.

	is the KEY!
The F appli	Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the key that opens the door to financial aid. It serves as the cation for most of the financial aid from federal and state programs and from colleges and universities. Even if re not sure that you will need financial aid, we recommend that you fill out a FAFSA anyway it's free.
	AFSA normally launches on October 1 each year. However, in 2023, the Department of Education is updating orm and it will not be available until December.
	n you file the 2023-24 FAFSA, you will use what the U.S. Department of Education calls the Prior Prior Year) for income information. This means that you will use your 2021 income information to complete the 2023-24 A.
or sta onlin	hould submit the FAFSA as soon after the official starting date as possible, making sure you meet any college ate deadlines. The quickest and most accurate way to file the FAFSA is online. In contrast to a paper copy, the e form displays only the data entry fields you need to complete. You also receive directions as you need them. FAFSA site is also available in Spanish.
	mplete the FAFSA you will need an FSA ID (Federal Student Aid), a username and password that enables you to to some Department of Education websites.
direc	nay wish to make use of the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT). This tool transfers your income tax information tly from the income tax form that you filed onto the FAFSA. You can read more about this process and find out your tax information will be available through the IRS DRT here.
	prefer to fill out a paper copy of the FAFSA, you can obtain one by calling the Federal Student Aid Information er at 1-800-4-FED-AID.
colleg	AFSA may not be the only form required to receive an award letter from a school. You must also complete the ge admissions process. Check with each of the colleges and universities you listed on your FAFSA to determine requirements.
subm	i filed your FAFSA electronically, you will receive an electronic Student Aid Report (SAR) within a few days of itting your completed FAFSA.
