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RELEASE NOTES SUMMARY

These release notes detail the product improvements and new features included in the September 6th, 2023, release.

Resolved Issues

- 1. The High School Planning menu was removed from the sub-menu in Your Portfolio for postsecondary and adult users.
- 2. The activity icons are no longer included when printing a student's portfolio.
- 3. The Save and Cancel buttons for the Focus Career Cluster activity were corrected, so that the Save button is first. The orange font was replaced by the standard blue font.
- 4. A parent/guardian invited to view a student account is no longer able to enter a different email address upon account creation.
- 5. Students can now upload PNG and JPEG files in the Evidence Documents section of the Assignment & Curriculum page.
- 6. When generating an Assignment & Curriculum report that includes Ability Profiler activity data, upon selecting the completion date for this activity, the user will now be directed to the student view of the portfolio page.
- 7. Upon completing the 'This is Me' activity, the text will no longer overlap when viewed in browser responsive mode.
- 8. When working with the Transferable Skills Checklist activity in Assigned Curriculum, the 'Complete the Transferable Skill Checklist again' button will no longer be truncated in responsive mode when using the Firefox browser.
- 9. When viewing the Assignment & Curriculum Builder in browser responsive mode, the 'Assignment & Curriculum Builder' header text will no longer overlap with the row border.
- 10. In schools that are using Common App and NCS for the application process, the chart, found on Colleges & Applications > Dashboard, is now displays application status information for the 2023/2024 school year.

Enhanced & New Features

- Updates were made to the Assignments & Curriculums page for both school and district curriculums to simplify the page and provide easier management of assigned and unassigned curriculums.
- Milestones and the Milestone Report were updated to reflect the same activities and activity names as the Assignment & Curriculum Builder.



1	Postsecondary and adult users do not have High School Planning in their main menu, but it is found in the sub-menu under Your Portfolio. (PPS-5243)	The High School Planning sub-menu was removed from the sub-menu in Your Portfolio for postsecondary and adult users.
2	When printing a student's portfolio, the activity icons are not displaying correctly. (PPS-5245)	The activity icons are no longer included when printing a student's portfolio.
3	When viewing the Focus Career Cluster activity, the Save and Cancel buttons are reversed and displayed in orange. (PPS-5246)	The Save and Cancel buttons for the Focus Career Cluster activity were corrected, so that the Save button is first. The orange font was replaced by the standard blue font.
4	When a parent/guardian receives an invitation from a student to create an account, and enters a different email address upon account creation, the student defined security question is not displayed. (PPS-2368)	A parent/guardian invited to view a student account is no longer able to enter a different email address upon account creation.
5	Students are not able to upload PNG or JPEG files in Evidence Documents on the Assignment & Curriculum page. (PPS-3931)	Students can now upload PNG and JPEG files in the Evidence Documents section of the Assignment & Curriculum page.
6	When generating an Assignment & Curriculum report that includes Ability Profiler data, upon selecting the completion date for this activity, the user is directed to the index page of the professional view of the student portfolio. (PPS-4145)	When generating an Assignment & Curriculum report that includes Ability Profiler data, upon selecting the completion date for this activity, the user will now be directed to the student view of the portfolio page.

10	In schools that are using Common App and NSC for the application process, the chart on Colleges & Applications > Dashboard, is displaying the application data for the previous school year. (PPS-5310)	In schools that are using Common App and NCS for the application process, the chart, on Colleges & Applications > Dashboard, now displays application status information for the 2023/2024 school year.


2. ASSIGNMENT & CURRICULUM BUILDER UPDATE

Updates were made to the Assignments & Curriculums page for both school and district curriculums. The assigned and unassigned curriculums will now appear on two pages with assigned curriculums as the default. The tiles were redesigned to make them easier to read.




Assignments & Curriculums Page

To add a new curriculum, select the New Curriculum button, and enter the curriculum name in the popup. Curriculum names must now be unique. When editing existing curriculums, duplicate curriculum names must be updated.




New Curriculum Modal

To access grades and groups, select the Assign Grades & Groups button. The default tab is the Assign Grade & Roles. The grades and roles have drop downs containing all curriculums that are currently not assigned to a group. Select one or multiple curriculums and save to assign them to grades and/or roles.




Assign Grades & Roles

Select the Assign Groups tab to associate curriculums to groups. Select a curriculum to display all groups. Only curriculums not currently assigned to a grade/role are found in the list. Once selected, all groups are displayed, along with a count of how many groups are associated to the selected curriculum. Professionals can also view just their groups from the group selector.



3. MILESTONES & MILESTONE REPORT REDESIGN



The national employment, job openings, and outlook data for O*NET Career Profiles was updated to the latest available data. The revised data is found in the Money & Outlook section of the Career Profile.



6. INCLUSIVE POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION BADGE



7. FINANCIAL AID 101


