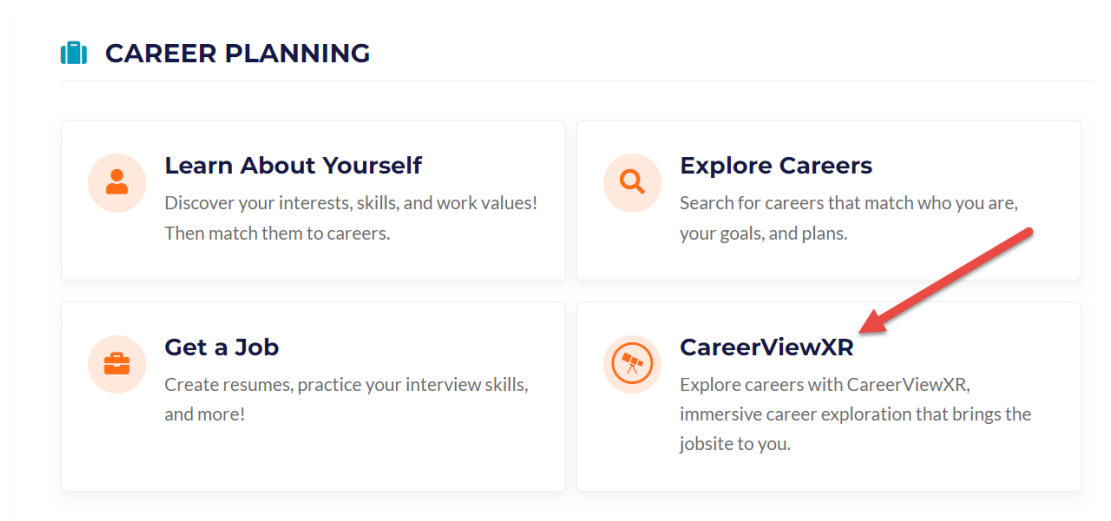

A new CareerViewXR badge was added to the Career Planning page.



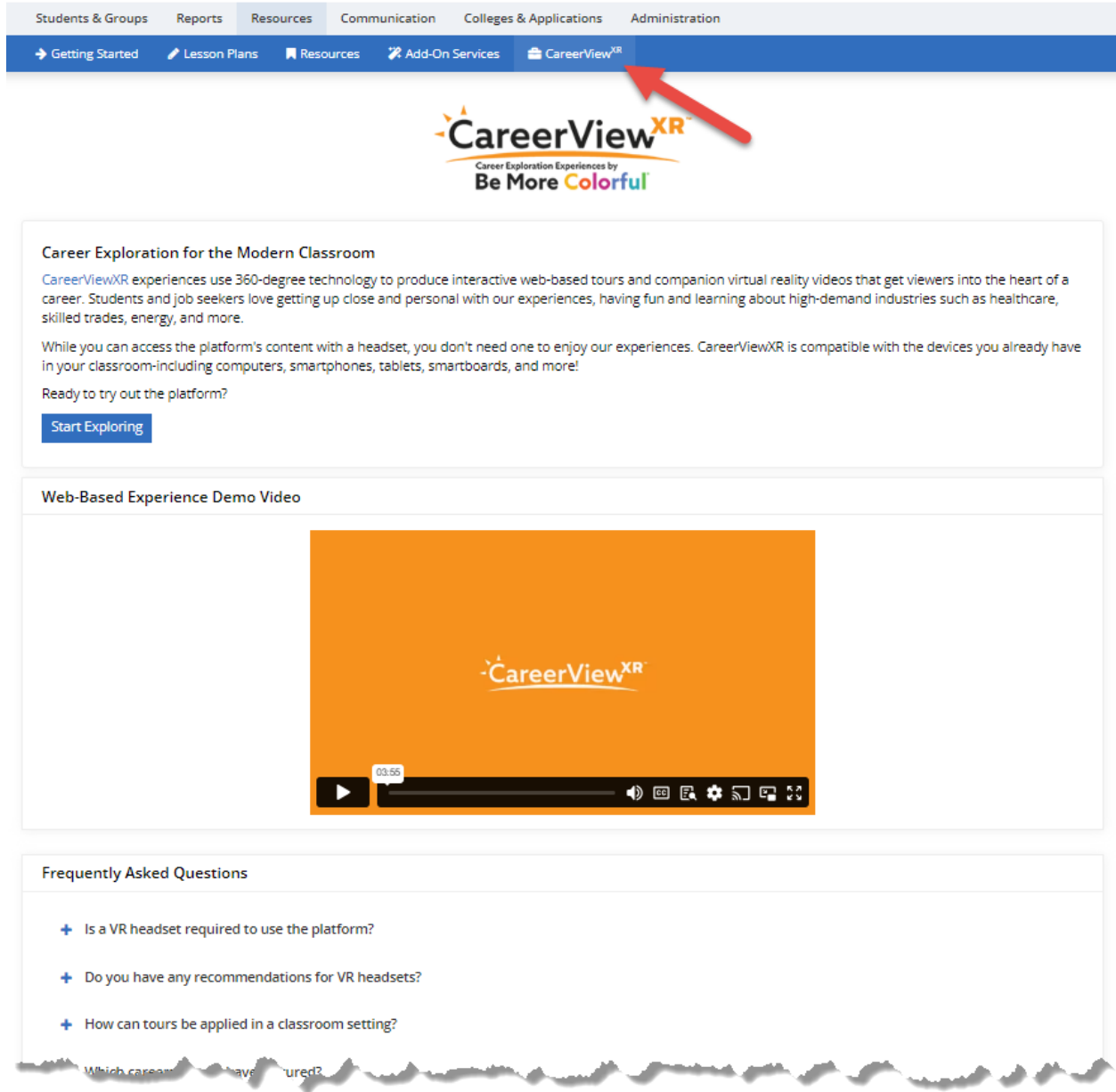
CareerViewXR Badge on the Career Planning Page
