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## ***RELEASE NOTES SUMMARY***

These release notes detail the product improvements and new features included in the July 25, 2024, release.

### **Resolved Issues**

- A. The print output for Postsecondary Plans (Your Portfolio) was missing the After High School Transition Plan.
- B. Text for career or technical schools in the activity, Directions After High School, was not displaying correctly.
- C. When the My Goals and Action Plans activity was assigned with more than one goal required for completion, the system was incorrectly determining when the activity was complete.
- D. Testing indicated that the Skip Navigation link (for screen readers) in the Scholarships feature in the Student Center was prompting errors.
- E. When resetting a student's password, a professional could enter a password longer than 12 letters in the text box.


## RESOLVED ISSUES

This table summarizes the product improvements included in the July 25, 2024, release.

	<b>Problem</b>	<b>Improvement</b>
A.	The print output for Postsecondary Plans (Your Portfolio) was missing the After High School Transition Plan (PPS-7029)	The print now includes the After High School Transition Plan activity.
B.	Text for career or technical schools in the activity, Directions After High School, was not displaying correctly. (PPS-7023)	The text is displayed correctly.
C.	When the My Goals and Action Plans activity was assigned with more than one goal required for completion, the system was incorrectly determining when the activity was complete. (PPS-2462)	The system now determines completion correctly.
D.	Testing indicated that the Skip Navigation link (for screen readers) in the Scholarships feature in the Student Center was prompting errors. (PPS-7192)	The Skip Navigation link was removed as it was not necessary.
E.	When resetting a student's password, a professional could enter a password longer than 12 characters in the text box. (PPS-7219)	The text box has been updated so a password longer than 12 characters cannot be entered.

## 1. ANNUAL AP COURSE UPDATE

Each year XAP updates the list of AP courses in the activity, AP Exams. In this activity students can select the AP courses for which they wrote the exam, their score, and the test date. The activity can be assigned to students using the Assignment & Curriculum Builder in the Professional Center.
