

Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) in order to qualify for aid through the federal government.

- The quickest and most accurate way to file the FAFSA is **online**. The online application is secure and includes online assistance and prompts. Paper applications may be requested by calling 800-433-3243. You also may **download** a PDF version of the FAFSA that can be submitted for processing.
- You can file the FAFSA any time after October 1 in the year before you will enter college. The FAFSA is undergoing upgrades. For the 2025-2026 FAFSA application, you will be able to begin applying on December 1st, 2024.
- Take me to fafsa.gov where I will complete the FAFSA application form.
- Be sure all the required signatures accompany the application.
