


Key Enhancements

1. Optional Phone & Email Fields Added to Work-based Learning Applications

Students are now asked to include a contact phone number and email address on their work-based learning application. This will help both the educator and the employer more easily reach out to arrange interviews or next steps. If an educator forwards a student's application to a GPS-originated opportunity, the email and/or phone is passed automatically to employer via GPS.

2. Improving Verification: Optional Phone Field for Volunteer Activities

Students can now include a contact phone number when logging their volunteer and community service activities, making it easier for educators to verify their experience. This streamlined validation process ensures accuracy while saving time for both students and educators.
