ITEMS NEEDED TO COMPLETE A FAFSA

Important: Be sure to create an account at StudentAid.gov before starting your FAFSA. Your parent(s) may also need to create their own StudentAid.gov account(s); see information below.

Before you begin the FAFSA, be sure to gather the following information:

- ➤ Your StudentAid.gov account username and password (see above)
- ➤ Your Social Security number
- ➤ Your alien registration number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- ➤ Your parent(s)' email address
- ➤ Your **2024** federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned
- ► The current total of your cash, savings and checking accounts
- ► Records of investments (if applicable)
- ► Records of untaxed income (if applicable)

If you're a dependent* student, your parent(s) will also need to create a StudentAid. gov account and provide the information listed above. Parents/spouses without Social Security numbers can also create their StudentAid.gov accounts.
