



HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENT: FAFSA COMPLETION

THE LAW

In Oklahoma, seniors must complete and submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) in order to graduate from a public high school. (Senate Bill 93)

If a student or parent chooses not to complete the FAFSA, an Opt Out form may be submitted instead. Students under 18 must have the form signed by a parent or legal guardian. Students who are 18 or older may complete and submit the form on their own. For more information about the Opt Out process, please contact your high school counselor.

FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)

The FAFSA is a student's first step in applying for federal and most state financial aid. The FAFSA determines the student's eligibility for financial assistance at the college, university, career technology center or proprietary school to which it's sent. Financial aid can include grants, work-study funding, scholarships and federal student loans. Students will complete the FAFSA annually in order to apply for aid.
