1. New Student Logins Report

We've introduced a new Student Logins Report in the Professional Center to give educators a clearer, more actionable view of student engagement in RUReadyND.gov. This report replaces the previous Accounts Created and Active Accounts reports with a more meaningful way to understand how students are using the platform.

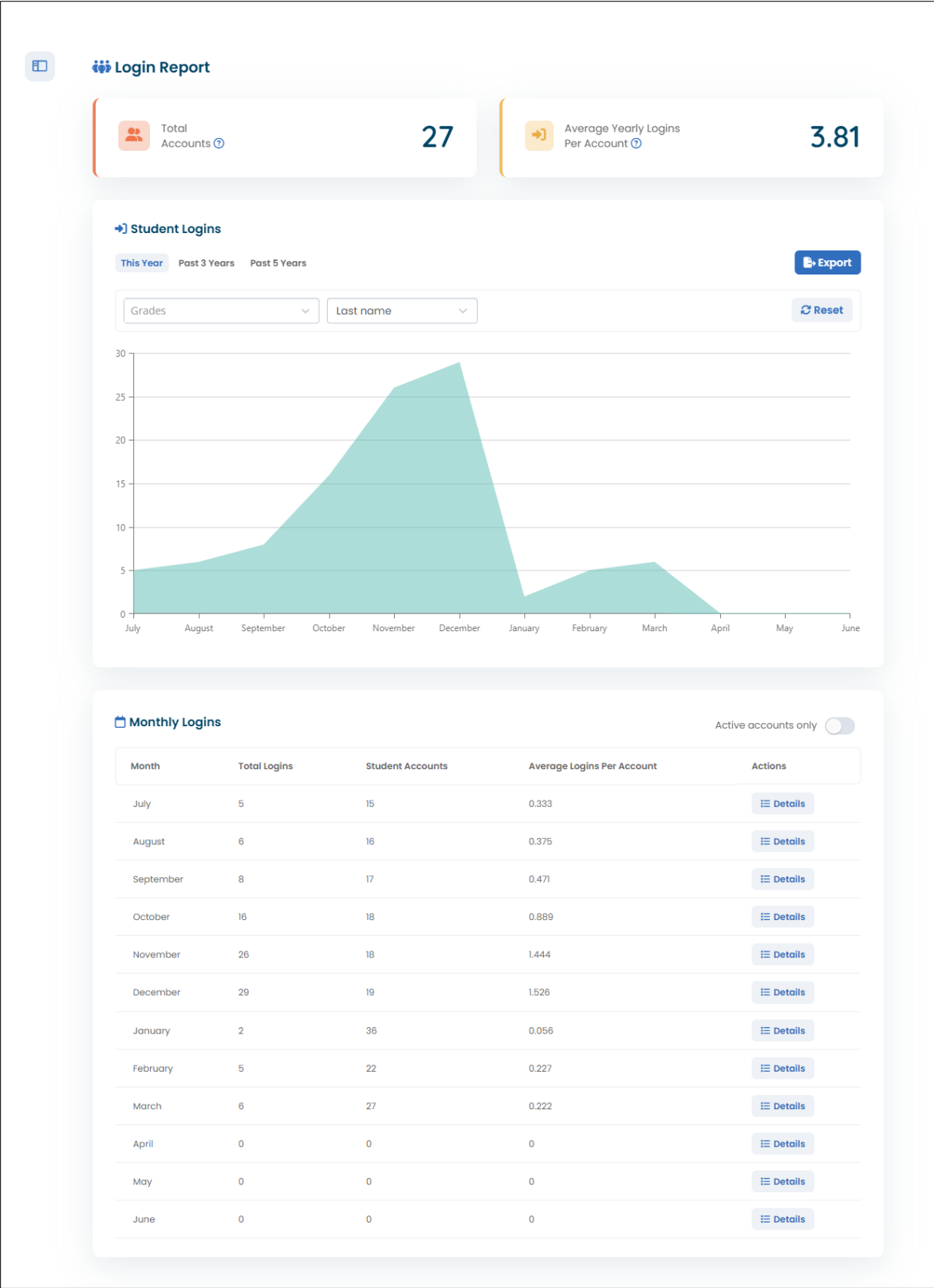
What This Means for Educators

Educators can now:

- **Understand student engagement more clearly**
View how often students are logging in across the school year with monthly and daily trends.
- **Focus on the students who need attention**
Filter by grade or student name range to quickly identify patterns and gaps in engagement.
- **Track meaningful usage metrics**
See total student accounts alongside average yearly logins per account for a more accurate picture of activity.
- **Measure engagement over time**
Compare login activity across the past 3 or 5 years to evaluate trends and progress.
- **Access detailed, student-level data**
Export login data with optional fields for deeper analysis, reporting, or sharing with stakeholders.

How It Works (At a Glance)

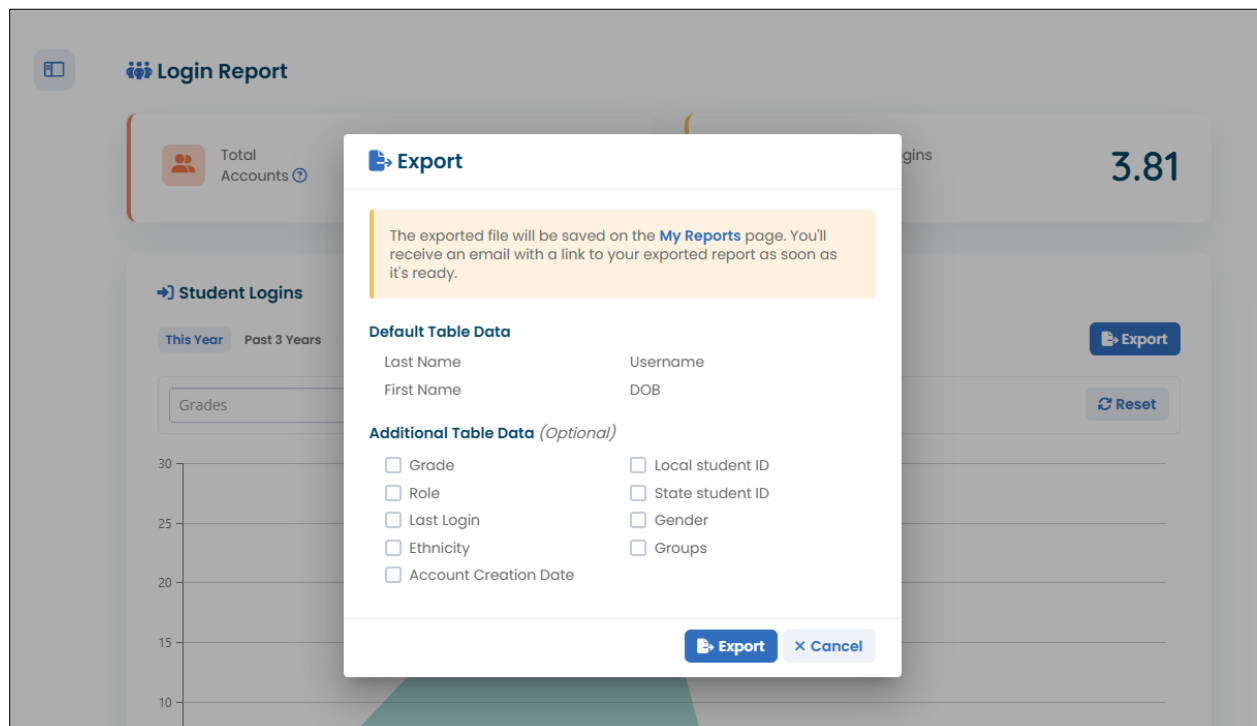
1. Navigate to **Reports** → **Logins** in the Professional Center.
2. View a **school-year summary** of login activity, including total accounts and average logins.
3. Use filters to refine results by grade or student segments.
4. Drill down into monthly and daily views to identify engagement patterns.
5. Export data for sharing or further analysis.



New Login Report in the Professional Center

Key Features

- **Streamlined Reporting Experience**
Replaces multiple legacy reports with a single, more intuitive view of student engagement.
- **Annual, Monthly, and Daily Views**
Start with a school-year overview, then drill down to monthly and daily activity.
- **Flexible Filtering**
Focus on specific student populations using grade, group, or alphabetical filters.
- **Year-Over-Year Comparisons**
Compare current activity to the past 3 or 5 academic years to identify trends.
- **Consistent Metrics at a Glance**
Summary tiles display total student accounts and average yearly logins per account for quick reference.
- **Exportable Data**
Download detailed student-level login data (XLSX) with customizable fields for deeper analysis.

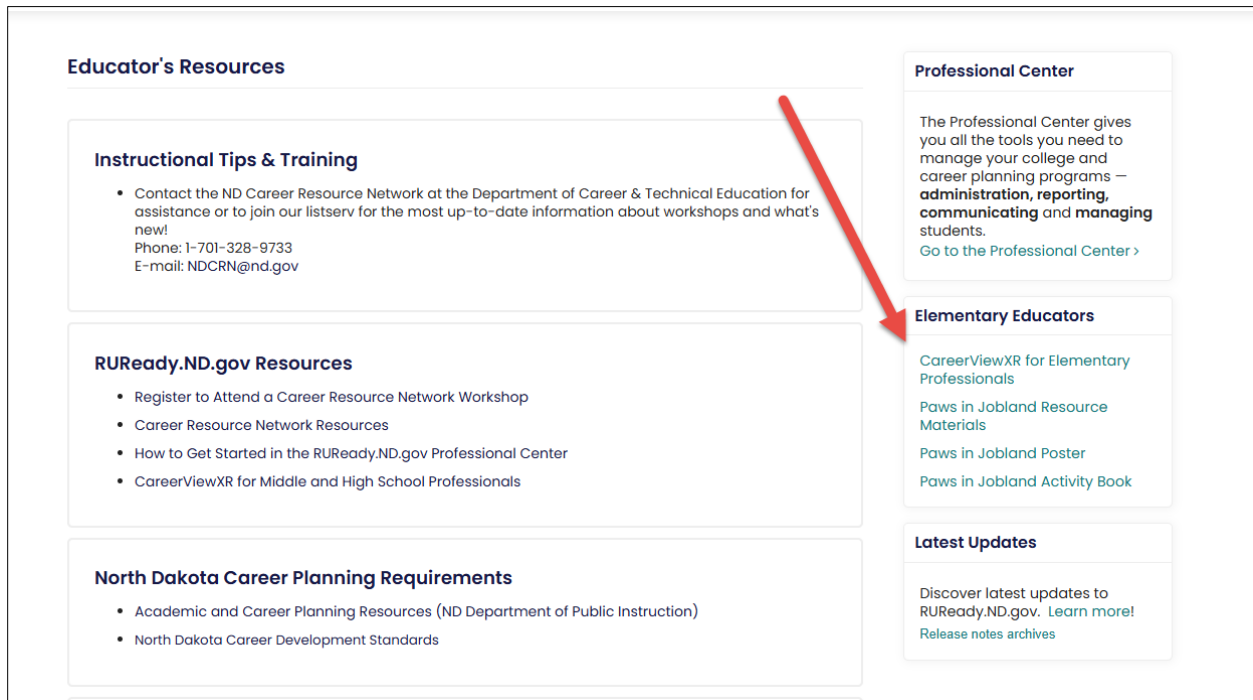

We're excited to introduce AchieveWorks assessments to RUReady.ND.gov. They're now available to all North Dakota public middle and high schools serving students in grades 6–12. These research-based assessments help students better understand themselves, build essential skills, and make more informed decisions about their academic and career pathways.

AchieveWorks Assessments














- **Learning & Productivity:** Helps students understand how they learn best, improving study habits, confidence, and academic performance. Backed by over 30 years of research.
- **Skills:** Measures communication, leadership, collaboration, resilience, critical thinking, and organization—key indicators of college, career, and life readiness.

- **Personality:** Provides insights into strengths, blind spots, career pathways, and interpersonal styles, along with personalized recommendations for careers and majors.
- **Intelligences:** Based on Multiple Intelligences theory, helping students identify strengths across nine intelligence areas and develop them further.

11	Skills, Learning & Productivity	Refine skills and apply learning strategies in preparation for postsecondary planning
12	Skills, Personality	Synthesize strengths, skills, and preferences to support postsecondary decisions
