1. Logins Report: Email Address Now Available as an Export Option

What's New

- A new Email checkbox has been added to the Additional Table Data section of the Student Logins report export modal, appearing as the first option in the list, above Grade.
- Like other optional fields, Email is unchecked by default.
- When selected, the exported file will include an Email column populated with each student's email address on file. If a student doesn't have an email on file, that field will simply export blank.

Benefit to Educators

- Gives staff an easy way to identify students with missing or outdated email addresses.

Bug Fixes & Improvements

- **Assigned Activities Progress Indicators** – Fixed an issue where the progress indicator for certain completed activities (for example, SAT Scores) stayed on its "not started" blue styling instead of switching to green, even though the activity itself showed as completed. Students and educators will now see consistent, accurate completion status across tracked activities.
- **Assignment & Curriculum Builder** – Fixed a bug that prevented administrators from setting the initial page to grades 3, 4, or 5 when building a curriculum assignment. Administrators can now properly configure the initial page for these grade levels.
- **Parent/Guardian Portfolio Navigation** – Fixed an issue where parents/guardians clicking links within a student's Plan of Study (such as Top Career Choice) were redirected to their own portfolio instead of the student's. Parent/guardian users can now navigate directly to the correct section of their student's portfolio.
- **Professional Center View of Student Portfolio Login Count** – The Number of Logins count has been updated. Previously, it included all logins over the lifetime of the account. It now includes only logins from the current school year, making it consistent with the other login counts.

- **Survey Results** - Survey questions with longer titles were being silently omitted from Excel exports of survey results, even though they displayed correctly on-screen and in print. This was caused by a 125-character limit on question titles in the export logic. The fix ensures all questions and their responses are now included in Excel exports, regardless of title length.
